

## Evolent Cardiology Solution Program Go-Live January 1, 2025

### High Level Partnership Responsibilities Across Entities

#### **Evolent:**

- Provider online portal 'CarePro' to submit your cardiovascular treatment requests.
- Evolent will perform UM functions (approvals and denials) and provider (ordering) notifications.
- Clinical policies for cardiovascular services.
- Auto-approval of requests that meet Pathway criteria. If auto-approval is not supported, requests are reviewed by a First Level Reviewer (nurse) and a Clinical Reviewer (Cardiologist) if needed.

#### **Iowa Total Care:**

- Will continue to hold responsibility for grievances and appeals.
- Member notifications.
- Claims management.
- Case management.
- Maintains day-to-day management of provider contracts.



Appropriate Use Criteria 'AUC'

Empowering Your Cardiology Clinical Team and Prior Authorization Staff to Work With Evolent

Review the Evolent cardiology tools for required information to support your request: Cardiology Pathways Guide – CPT-ICD 10 Cardiology Crosswalk

Prepare Complete, Clear Notes	<ul> <li>Document your intent to perform the requested service and the medical necessity for doing so; use the 'Cardio Pathways Guide' that is hyperlinked within each request to ensure your notes align with the approval criteria.</li> <li>Include notes on any member limitations that require use of the desired service instead of alternatives.</li> </ul>
Attach Required Clinical Notes	<ul> <li>Required supporting information can be attached to your request; this helps to avoid any delays in member care, reduces the need for Evolent peer-to-peer calls, and avoids denials.</li> </ul>
Expedite Requests Judiciously	<ul> <li>CMS defines an expedited request as one for which "the standard timeframe could seriously jeopardize the patient's life or health".</li> <li>Evolent has short turnaround times to review expedited requests, so if we cannot reach you to discuss a request when needed, it is likely to result in a denial.</li> </ul>
Mind Frequency Guideline Alerts	<ul> <li>Evolent frequency guidelines monitor requests placed by your office AND other provider offices.</li> <li>If you must request a service that exceeds the frequency guideline, provide required supporting rationale in the clinical notes.</li> </ul>
