Member Story: Connection Leads to Behavioral Health



An Iowa Total Care member was a frequent patient at hospitals because of unmanaged behavioral health. It was a cry for help, but the contact numbers in the member's system did not connect with the member.

Member Services searched at length through outside documents for a connecting number. The extra effort paid off when contact was made with the member. The connection seemed to happen at just the right time; the member was ready to take ownership and action on behavioral health.

The member agreed to ongoing behavioral health services arranged by Iowa Total Care. The member was connected to an Iowa Total Care case manager. Now this member is actively involved in the process of improving self-behavioral health, all because a connection was made.



Recipe of the Month:

Rotisserie Chicken Burrito Bowls

INGREDIENTS

- 2 cups instant brown rice
- 2½ cups shredded rotisserie chicken
- ½ 1.25-ounce package of 25% less sodium taco seasoning mix
- ½ cup water
- 115-ounce can no-salt-added black beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 cup shredded 2% reduced-fat cheddar cheese
- Optional toppings: salsa, black olives, avocados, plain Greek yogurt





INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cook rice according to package directions; set aside and keep warm.
- 2. Warm chicken and taco seasoning in a skillet over medium-low heat. Add water and cook until water has absorbed.
- 3. To assemble, layer ½ cup rice, ¼ chicken mixture, ¼ black beans, ½ cup cheese, and desired toppings into each of 4 serving bowls.

Iowa Total Care Receives Heroes for Homeless Award for Collaboration with CISS

Central Iowa Shelter and Services (CISS) presented Iowa Total Care (ITC) with the Heroes for the Homeless Award on May 2 to recognize our dedication to the homeless community as well as our support in the development of the Housing Command Center (HCC) and SDoH app.

In June, CISS launched the limited-release testing version of their innovative SDoH app, Bindl! Iowa Total Care has a few team members currently testing this version. Additional versions of the app are anticipated later this summer. This app features a unique function enabling homeless individuals to monitor their progress through the support process in real-time.

The Housing Command Center project is progressing smoothly across the three locations:

- **Des Moines**: Main location for CISS is currently supporting the Housing Command Center and has served 338 people since the project began in late 2023.
- **Grinnel**l: The Grinnell location has been purchased by CISS and will be opening later in 2024. Construction plans begin in 2025.
- Ottumwa: CISS anticipates owning this property in late 2023 with construction plans scheduled to commence in 2025.

Working with CISS, we are committed to enhancing support for our homeless community through our partnered groundbreaking initiatives.
